

Scottish Airway Group 2020 / 2021

Research and Education Bursary Award Scheme

The Scottish Airway Group would like to invite applications for its Research and Education Bursary Award Scheme, granted for projects contributing to research and education in airway management within Scotland.

Application for research funding should outline the proposal in detail. Application for educational projects should include details of teaching programmes/material and planned mechanisms for feedback. Proposed educational material must avoid duplication of resources already in the public domain or highlight specific reasons as to why proposed work is an improvement. Applicants must specify how material will be disseminated.

Plans for publication of any written material or research should include acknowledgement of SAG funding. Appropriate material may be uploaded as content to the SAG website.

Applications are made by way of an abstract detailing project justification, project aims and project methods. Costings must be included. Award of up to £1000 will be available. Applications should be typed, font Times New Roman size 10, single spacing, and fit one side of A4. This should be to be submitted electronically to <u>simon.crawley@nhs.scot</u>. Deadline for submission is the 31st of January 2021.

Successful applicants will be invited to submit abstracts to present their work as a poster or oral presentation, at the annual Scottish Airway Group meetings.

Successful applicants must have access to an identified bank account for receipt of funds.
